Re: Support for Application 2010-1168-4
for a Technical Amendment to
CHIN Radio's 91.9 FM transmitter CHIN-1-FM

Villa Charities has been developing community projects and programmes since 1971 (soon to be our 40th Anniversary), almost as long as CHIN's 45 years of broadcasting life. During this time Villa Charities developed Villa Colombo Services for Seniors, VITA Community Living Services, group homes and programmes for the developmentally handicapped, Columbus Centre and Carrier Art Gallery, a social, cultural and recreational community centre and Caboto Terrace, Casa Del Zotto and Casa Abruzzo, housing for senior citizens. Our last project completed was Villa Colombo Vaughan, a long-term, care facility located 30 km. from our original campus in the City of Vaughan. Today this family of organizations provides housing and care to over 1,500 seniors, community living services to over 400 developmentally handicapped adults and their families as well as those thousands of others who take advantage of art, cultural and recreational classes.

This success is due, in part, to the excellent co-operation Villa Charities has had with Italian language, culturally-sensitive media in general and CHIN Radio, in particular, who has helped us inform, share and sensitize our events within the community as well as assist us in raising funds and support for our community work.

We support CHIN Radio's request to increase the FM 91.1 repeater power in order to have better reception of CHIN AM 1540 Italian programmes. The community has moved further northwest and so should the CHIN power.


