Subject: Lansdowne Rural Telephone Company -- Part I application requesting that the Commission finds that Rogers Wireless Home Phone Service is a local exchange service that Rogers should be offering as a CLEC

1. Lansdowne Rural Telephone Company is in receipt of a Part 1 application, dated 9 October 2013, by Wightman Telecom Ltd. ("Wightman") requesting that the Commission find that Rogers Wireless Home Phone Service is a local exchange that Rogers should be offering as a CLEC.
2. Lansdowne Rural Telephone Company agrees with Wightman's argument that the Commission should evaluate the regulatory status of Rogers' service using the principles contained in *Regulatory framework for voice communication services using Internet Protocol* - Telecom Decision CRTC 2005-28, 12 May 2005. Lansdowne Rural Telephone Company also agrees with Wightman that based on the evidence it has presented, Rogers Wireless Home Phone meets the same general user requirement as circuit switched local exchange services and it's therefore a local exchange service that Rogers should be offering as a CLEC.
3. Lansdowne Rural Telephone Company submits that the Commission should grant Wightman the relief it requests in its application.
