We are the solicitors for the Canadian Association of Community Television Users and Stations (CACTUS).


On February 9, 2016, CACTUS filed a proposal for a trial of its Community Media Centre proposal in answer to an undertaking given by CACTUS during its January 26, 2016 appearance before the Commission panel in the above-noted proceeding. Upon a further review of the CACTUS submission an error in the text of the proposal was discovered. This error is at the top of page 11. The estimated range for the cost of the three year trial proposal is incorrectly stated on page 11 as being \$15,659,600 to \$24,754,900. The correct estimated cost range is \$10,667,930 to \$24,596,500 in order to match up with the estimated cost range set out in Section 3 of the proposal.

A copy of the amended page 11 as well as a full version of the amended proposal is attached to this letter. CACTUS hereby requests that the corrected page be included as part of the public record of this proceeding.
